

WHICH NEST IS BEST?

Now that you've chosen a potential site for your play, go through our handy dandy checklist to see if it's the right space for you. Give yourself 2 points for a YES, 1 point for a MAYBE and 0 points for a NO.

Add up your total score at the end to see your results!

QUESTIONS:	YES (2)	MAYBE (1)	NO (0)
Is there a clear sight line to the stage area?			
Is the audience protected from looking into the sun?			
Is the performance area clear of shadows that may block the action?			
Is the space small enough that your voices will carry to the whole audience?			
Will the audience be able to hear over the wind?			
Is the performance area free of distracting traffic and/or animal noises?			
Is the ground comfortable to sit on (free of puddles, prickly plants, distracting insects, etc.)?			
Is the entire area free of poisonous plants such as poison ivy and poison parsnip?			
Is the entire area free of plants that cause common allergies?			
Can you use elements of the natural area to enhance your play (set, props, sounds, staging, etc.)?

<p>SCORES:</p> <p>16-20 points - YES! You've chosen a great location for your play. Your environment will enhance your performance and your audience will be able to follow the action in comfort. Break a leg!</p> <p>11-15 points - MAYBE Is there anything you can do to modify your chosen location to make it more suitable for your performance? Can you change the time of the performance so that there are fewer distractions or so that the area is more comfy for the audience? If you make changes, try the checklist again to see if it's a YES!</p> <p>0-10 points - NO This is not the ideal location for a performance. The hard work that you've put into developing your play will not be able to be appreciated by the audience. Keep looking for a better location.</p>
